The Yellowstone Basin Food Pantry Collaborative (YBFPC) is a regional partnership of pantries within the **Montana Food Pantry Collaborative**. Together, we work to support one another, share resources, and enhance rural food access across the region. As part of this collaboration, the Livingston Food Resource Center contributes fresh, low glycemic, preservative free scratch-made bread to our communities.

Projected Loaves per Month

- **1,000 loaves** to Helping Hands Food Pantry (Big Horn County)
- **300 loaves** to Northern Cheyenne Food Pantry (Lame Deer County)
- **300 loaves** to Gardiner Food Pantry (Park County)
- **700 loaves** retained for the Livingston Food Resource Center (Park County)

And provides nutritious, preservative-free bread made from locally grown, native grains to our most vulnerable community members across three rural counties, including those in two tribal nations, ensuring access to nutritious and delicious food where it's needed most.
